Key Tour Information

- Full-day land-based tour of Bruny Island from Hobart
- Highlights: Enjoy award winning cheeses, premium wines and beer, freshly shucked oysters, handmade fudge, mead, ice cream, local honey, and lunch at Pennicott's beachside restaurant
- Departure Point: Dock Head Building, Franklin Wharf or Hobart Hotel pick-up available
- Departs 7.45am daily, returning approximately 5.30/6.00pm

Hobart Office

- Centrally located on the Hobart waterfront this is an easy meeting point to begin your journey
- Address: Dock Head Building, Franklin Wharf, Hobart
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to your tour departure time
- There is time restricted parking available opposite the office including an accessible car park for pick-up and drop-off
- The closest all-day parking is available at either:
 - Argyle Street Carpark 500 metres away, undercover car-parking
 - Market Place Carpark 400 metres away, undercover car-parking
 - Evans Street Carpark 550 metres away, open-air parking
- Taxi or Uber is also available to our Hobart office
- There is ramped entry to the booking office where you will meet for the tour

Itinerary and Access

- Throughout the day we stop at many different sites on Bruny Island
- There is no pressure to join at each stop but do note that you will be in and out of the bus several times throughout the day

Bruny Island Cheese and Beer Company

- 80 metres from bus to tasting area. Gently sloping gravel path with ramped access to building
- Seated tasting experience in an undercover area
- Accessible toilet facilities available

Truganini Lookout (The Neck)

- Bus will park alongside concrete footpath to access track. Track is board walked, with either 235 steps to the top point of the lookout, or a 250m each way path to a beach viewing point
- Accessible toilet facilities available

Mavista Rainforest Walk

- Bus will park in gravel parking area. 20 steps to walk starting point
- From there it is a sloping path. You can turn around and return to the start point at any point in the walk, it is an out and back track not a loop
- The track at times can be slightly muddy with the risk of fallen branches requiring you to bend underneath them


Pennicott's Beachside Restaurant

- Pennicott's Beachside Restaurant is located at 1005 Adventure Bay Road, Adventure Bay.
 The bus will stop outside a set of 5 steps, with a ramp option also available
- The door into the entrance foyer is a 1050mm wide manual door





- From the entrance foyer, there is either a 19-step spiral staircase or an elevator. The elevator is around the corner to the right from when you enter the foyer
- Elevator Dimensions: 890mm Wide x 1500mm Depth
- Once at the top of the stairs or elevator, this is the main level with accessible toilets, gift shop, reception desk and restaurant
- The flooring is a combination of polished concrete and polished floorboards





Bligh Museum

- Bus will park directly out front of the museum
- There are 4 steps into the building with level access throughout
- It is a smaller space, with lots of display cases

Two Tree Point Beach Walk

- Bus will park in a gravel parking area with direct beach access
- This path can be uneven at times due to coastal erosion

HIBA Gardens & Bruny Island Chocolate Company

- Bus will park in a parking area outside the shop area.
- The garden tour is throughout the large property. We may walk up to 1.5km during the tour
- The paths are a mixture of grass, gravel and sandstone steps. The property is sloping in sections
- There is a seating area at the top point of the garden where you can sit and enjoy the view, or join for a short portion of the tour and then return

Bruny Island Honey

- Bus will park directly outside the shop area. There is either 10 steps inside, or ramped access
- Balcony area and shop are level throughout

Buses

- The type of bus used varies daily based on operational considerations
- The buses are air-conditioned and have seatbelts fitted
- The buses are not wheelchair accessible and do have steps to board but do have storage available for standard sized collapsible wheelchairs and walkers

37-Seat Bonluck Coaches

- The access door is 670mm wide
- First step is 230mm high, followed by 5 steps at 170mm high
- Aisle width is 350mm. Legroom is 300mm with a seat width of 460mm
- There is a large luggage area for walkers and wheelchairs







20-Seat Toyota Coaster

- The access door is 650mm wide
- First step is 170mm high, second step 90mm high, third step 300mm high
- Aisle width is 400mm. Legroom is 210mm with a seat width of 460mm
